



VOLUNTEER PARTICIPATION

In recent years, OSA has experienced a tremendous increase in its membership. This growth is expected to continue with all of the new development in the Oconomowoc area. As a result, OSA needs the help and commitment of more of its parents to meet the challenges associated with this growth and to ensure a positive soccer experience for our children. This past year, the board voted to install a refundable, \$70 volunteer fee program in order to encourage more OSA family members to become active participants in OSA and keep soccer alive in our community.

Highlights of the VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

- \$70 is automatically added to your only or oldest child's registration fee.
- After you have fulfilled a minimum of seven hours of service, and completed and turned in your OSA Volunteer Form to the OSA office by the December or June deadline, you will be reimbursed this fee.
- If you volunteer more than seven hours, OSA and the children thank you for your extra time. You may not transfer your extra hours to another family.
- Fees will be reimbursed twice a year: December and June.
- There will be no partial reimbursements. (Ex.- if you serve less than seven hours)
- To be fair and equitable to all members, volunteers will need to sign in and out with the coordinator for each job/activity.
- Hours will be verified, tracked, and filed using your submitted information together with the sign-in sheets. You will be responsible for turning in your hours, in writing, to the OSA office before the December and June deadlines.
- You may choose to opt out of volunteering but you will still be paying the \$70 fee. Please make sure your registration form has indicated that you wish to opt out. No refund will be issued.
- Service/volunteer hours for each season will begin immediately **after** the OSA recreational soccer tournament held the first weekend in June and run through the tournament the following year.
- Coaches, assistant coaches and team managers will automatically qualify for fulfilling the volunteer hours. No coordinator's signature is required unless a coach, assistant coach or team manager is added after the initial rosters have been distributed.
- When registering, please check the appropriate box with an area of interest that you have in helping us. We will do our best to honor your preferences but realize that we need more help in some areas than others.
- You are responsible for keeping track of your own hours, obtaining any necessary signatures and turning the form in on time. If you lose your form, you are responsible for completing and turning in another one. Please keep track of your forms!
